

What do smart meters do?

The smart meter in-home display (IHD) shows you how much energy you are using in near-real time so you can see exactly how much you're spending on energy - rather than waiting for your energy bill.

Why should I get one?

Once you have a smart meter you could get your energy bills under control by using the smart meter IHD to identify what appliances are using loads of energy. For example, you could save around £35 a year just by remembering to turn your appliances off standby mode*.

How do I get one?

If you pay the energy bill yourself simply phone your energy provider to register your interest. The time it takes to get one installed will depend on where you live and which energy provider you are with. If your landlord pays the energy bill directly, ask them to contact the energy provider to request a smart meter for your property.
